A Memorial Resolution Honoring Robert Henry 'Bob' Rohlf

Whereas the American Library Association (ALA), the Minnesota Library Association (MLA), and the public library community lost a valued member and colleague on June 6, 2017, with the death of Robert Henry 'Bob' Rohlf;

Whereas Robert Rohlf was the founding Director of Minnesota's first multi-county public library system, the Dakota-Scott Regional Library;

Whereas, he was recruited to the Library of Congress as Coordinator of Building Planning for the proposed James Madison Memorial Library in Washington, the largest library building in the world;
